- That the amount spent on trophies be increased to 60%

Trophy and engraving costs have been about 50% of entry fees but trophies are increasing in price. The increase has partly been absorbed by our supplier reducing the cost of engraving. We can expect to see further increases in costs. We can reduce the size of trophies to partly offset the increased cost, move to more medals or reduce the profit tournaments make. The added 10% will be about \$500.

Entry into National Championships has not been included as they were not paid out last season. Allocation money that is not used reduces the amount available for other uses.
