

Tournament Sub-Committee Report February 2019

Since the last WPA meeting there have been the following tournaments run by the tournament sub-committee:

WPA Open Triples. This tournament was held at Otaki on 8th December and attracted 22 entries which was 1 more than 2017 and 9 more than in 2016. This number of entries vindicates the tournament being held in a more central location. However, it still doesn't attract players from outside the WPA Region.

2019 Interclub.

Held at Kapiti. There was one less club entered than 2018. This gave 8 entries in Division One and so it was decided that it was unnecessary to play under a Swiss Draw format and instead clubs were divided into 2 pools of 4 based on the finishing position from the previous year.

Winners of Pool One were Masterton on 3 wins, followed by Manawatu on 2 wins, Horowhenua on 1 win and Otaki with 0 wins.

Winners of Pool Two were Kapiti – 3 wins, Silverstream 2nd on 1 win +11, Naenae 3rd on 1 win -21 and 4th Upper Hutt 1 win -33. In the semi-finals Masterton defeated Silverstream and Kapiti defeated Manawatu. The final was won by Kapiti. Silverstream defeated Manawatu to take 3rd place.

For positions 5 and 6th places Upper Hutt defeated Naenae and Otaki defeated Horowhenua to take out 7th place.
